STITCHED STOCKING

Christmas Card



AT A GLANCE

- Monochromatic design in Pecan Pie, Crumb Cake & white
- Paper pieced stocking for a cozy quilted look
- Easy to create with beautiful details
- Perfect for holiday card giving!

TIPS & DETAILS

- Color the Adhesive-Backed Mini Christmas Button with Crumb Cake Blends to coordinate.
- Use the pokey end of the Take Your Pick Tool to open the button holes before threading Linen Thread.
- Cut paper sections from the designer paper that work with the color scheme, then die cut, cut apart, and layer on a Pecan Pie stocking base.
- Add Antique Pearls for an elegant finishing touch.

- Ink: Versamark
- Basics Wow! Embossing Powder (white)
- A Stitched Season Designer Paper
- Adhesives

CARD BASE & LAYERS

- **Card Base:** Pecan Pie
11" x 4-1/4", scored at 5-1/2"
- **Layer 2:** Very Vanilla
4" x 5-1/4" (stamped around edges with Stitched Snowflakes in Crumb Cake ink)
- **Layer 3:** Crumb Cake (Stitched Rectangle Die)
approx. 3-3/4" x 5"
