MEASUREMENTS

Thick Basic White Cardstock card base
8 ½" x 5 ½", score at 4 ¼"

Basic Beige Cardstock for die cutting
4 ¼" x 2 ¾"

Fluid 100 Watercolor Paper layer & for
stamping
5" x 7"

Designer Series Paper strips
1" x 5 ½" blue woodgrain pattern
¾" x 5 ½" dark woodgrain pattern

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fold card base in half. Adhere the strip of blue woodgrain Designer Series Paper to the left-hand side of the card front.
2. Cut a panel of Fluid 100 Watercolor Paper measuring 3 ½" x 5 ½". *Retain what's left over for later steps.*
3. Using Misty Moonlight Classic Stampin' Ink™ and the larger sea image from the Sunset Coast Photopolymer Stamp Set, stamp the sea towards the top third of your Watercolor Paper panel. Immediately rotate the stamp and, using the remaining ink rather than reinking the stamp, stamp again (2nd generation stamping) to create the sky.
4. Using a Water Painter and a light touch, gently blend over the stamped sky, following the ink lines. Repeat for the sea, taking care not to pull ink into the areas where the sun reflection will sit. Allow to dry.
5. Mask off the sea along the horizon line. Using Golden Glow Ink, stamp the sun image in the center, overlapping the masked horizon. Remove the mask.
6. Using the smaller sea image with Golden Glow Ink, stamping off first, fill the reflection lines below the sun. Repeat above the sun to softly extend detail into the sky.

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7. Adhere the strip of dark woodgrain DSP to the reverse of the left-hand side of the watercolor paper panel so that a skinny strip is visible from the front. Adhere the entire panel to the card front.
8. Die cut the net element from the Sunset Coast Dies from Basic Beige Cardstock and adhere to the left-hand side of the stamped scene with Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
9. Stamp the sentiment on Basic White Cardstock using Secret Sea Ink, carefully cut out with scissors, and adhere using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Die cut one starfish, clam shell, and spiral shell from the left-over Watercolor Paper. Using a Water Painter, color the starfish with Golden Glow Ink, the clam shell with Golden Glow and Timid Tiger Inks, and the spiral shell with Pecan Pie Ink.
11. Take the boat scene die and cut just the strips at the bottom from Watercolor Paper, and color with Mossy Meadow Ink. Cut the longer strip in half.
12. Once the pieces are dry, arrange in a cluster and adhere to the left of the sentiment, over the fishing net.
13. Take a 13 ½" length of Linen Thread and tie a loose bow. Add to the cluster using a Mini Glue Dot and trim.
14. Finish with Sunset Sparkle Sequins.
15. To decorate the inside of the card, stamp the second part of the sentiment in Secret Sea Ink in the bottom right corner. Stamp the smaller sea image using Misty Moonlight Ink, stamped off first, and finish with a boat stamped using Secret Sea Ink.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fold card base in half. Adhere the Basic White Cardstock insert to the inside of the card.
2. Stamp the smaller sea image from the Sunset Coast Photopolymer Stamp Set with Pecan Pie Classic Stampin' Ink in the top left and bottom right corners of the card front.
3. Distress the edges of both the blue and dark woodgrain Designer Series Paper pieces using the blade of a pair of scissors. Curl back the top left and bottom right corners of each piece. Adhere the blue DSP piece to the middle of the dark woodgrain piece.
4. Stamp the larger sea image on the Basic White Cardstock layer using Misty Moonlight Ink.
5. Mask off the sea along the horizon line. Using a Blending Brush, apply Golden Glow Ink along the horizon, blending upwards for approximately 1". Add a touch of Timid Tiger Ink along the horizon line for depth.
6. Using Golden Glow Ink, stamp the sun image in the center, overlapping the masked horizon.

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7. Remove the mask, then stamp the smaller sea image using Golden Glow Ink to create the sun's reflection.
8. Die cut birds with the die from the Sunset Coast Dies from the middle of the Secret Sea Cardstock layer and put to one side. Adhere the stamped Basic White panel to the Secret Sea layer.
9. Die cut the boat from both Basic Beige and Pecan Pie Cardstock. Trim the sails from the Basic Beige piece and adhere over the sails on the Pecan Pie boat. Add to the left-hand side of the stamped scene using Stampin' Dimensionals.
10. Add one of the die-cut birds to the top right of the stamped panel using Multipurpose Liquid Glue.
11. Wrap a 6" length of Linen Thread around the layered panel, looping it through the top of the Anchor Trinket. Secure the thread at the back. Add the panel to the card front using Dimensionals.
12. Stamp the sentiment on Basic White Cardstock using Secret Sea Ink, trim, and adhere with Dimensionals centrally over the thread, keeping the anchor positioned to the right.
13. Take a 13 ½" length of Linen Thread and tie in a bow. Attach to the top of the Anchor Trinket using a Mini Glue Dot.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fold both card bases in half. Trim a very narrow strip from one edge of the Basic White card base. Combining the two (placing the Basic White card base inside the Secret Sea card base, with it opening in the opposite direction) will allow you to create a tri-fold card base. *Do not adhere them yet.*
2. Align the Basic Beige layer with the Secret Sea card front. Using the lighthouse scene die from the Sunset Coast Dies, die cut through both layers at the same time. If the die doesn't cut all the way through the Secret Sea layer, you can use the indentations to align the die to run it through the Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine again.
3. Keep the Basic Beige pieces from the sandbank area, and the sky section from the Secret Sea layer. Use the Take Your Pick Tool to remove all the other pieces from the Basic Beige layer. Remove the pieces from the top of the lighthouse from the Secret Sea layer, and any other bits you want to remove.
4. Layer the die cut Basic Beige and Secret Sea panels together, using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals to support the lighthouse part, and regular Dimensionals for the main panel.
5. To stamp the scene for the inside of the tri-fold card, you will be stamping on the back of the Basic White card base (i.e. folded edge to the right rather than left). Place the Basic White card

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- base inside the Secret Sea card base and use a pencil to lightly mark the level of the horizon line through the die cut scene and then remove it to stamp your scene.
- Stamp the larger sea image using Misty Moonlight Classic Stampin' Ink, offsetting to the left, then stamp again to the right with slight overlap. Stamp the smaller sea image using Misty Moonlight Ink, stamped off first, to fill in the water.
 - Mask off the sea along the horizon line. Using a Blending Brush, apply Golden Glow Ink along the horizon, blending upwards for approximately 1". Add a touch of Timid Tiger Ink along the horizon line for depth.
 - Stamp the detailed rock arch using Pecan Pie Ink, then stamp the coordinating solid image in with Pecan Pie, stamped off first, for depth.
 - Adhere the Basic White card base inside the Secret Sea card base (i.e. adhere the left panel of the Basic White card base to the right panel of the inside of the Secret Sea card base) to complete the tri-fold construction.
 - Looking through the aperture on the card front, determine the placement for the clouds. Stamp the cloud image using Secret Sea Ink, stamping off three times before stamping on the cardstock for a soft effect.
 - Stamp three boats using Secret Sea Ink, positioning so that two are visible through the aperture.
 - Die cut a set of birds from the sky section of Secret Sea Cardstock you kept from earlier. Adhere two birds to the cloud formation, checking placement from the front of the card, and add the remaining bird to the outer panel.
 - Fully open the card and stamp the sentiment inside on the center panel. Mask along the top edge of the sentiment and stamp the sun using Golden Glow Ink, then using a Blending Brush, lightly blend the same color with a touch of Timid Tiger Ink to create a soft sunrise effect.
 - Take the Basic Beige pieces from the sandbank area that you kept from before and use a Water Painter to lightly add Mossy Meadow Ink to create grasses, cutting the longer pieces in half. Die cut two fence panels from Pecan Pie cardstock. Adhere the grass and fence elements on the card front towards the bottom of the aperture.
 - Stamp the sentiment on Basic White Cardstock and trim to size.
 - Take a 13 1/2" length of Linen Thread and tie in a bow. Adhere to the back of the sentiment strip with a Mini Glue Dot and add to the card front using Dimensionals.
 - Finish with Sunset Sparkle Sequins.
