WILD BUNCH Etch A Sketch BIRTHDAY CARD



This playful birthday card brings back childhood memories with an Etch A Sketch inspired design! Featuring the adorable Wild Bunch stamp set, it's a fun, nostalgic way to send birthday wishes filled with love and a little bit of whimsy.

CARD SIZE (TOP FOLD)

4-1/4" x 11"
Scored at 5-1/2"
to fold at the top



REAL RED • BASIC WHITE • SMOKY SLATE

MEASUREMENTS

- **Card Base**
Basic White Cardstock
4-1/4" x 11"
Scored at 5-1/2" (top fold)
- **Real Red Frame**
Cut the opening from the card front, leaving a 3/4" frame all the way around.
- **Screen Layer – Smoky Slate Cardstock**
4-1/2" x 3-1/4"
- **Peek-Through Window**
Cut out with Paper Trimmer (measurements below)
3-1/2" x 4-3/4"
(centered in the frame)
- **Knobs (x2) – Basic White Cardstock**
Cut with Stylish Shapes Dies (circle)
approx. 1" diameter



HOW IT COMES TOGETHER

- 1 Stamp the Wild Bunch animals on the Smoky Slate cardstock.
- 2 Stamp "Happy Birthday" and "Sending Love" on the Real Red frame with VersaMark Ink and heat emboss in White.
- 3 Cut the center opening, leaving a 3/4" frame all the way around.
- 4 Round all corners of the frame and card base.
- 5 Attach the stamped Smoky Slate layer behind the frame.
- 6 Add the die-cut knobs with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- 7 Adhere the completed piece to the card front.

- **Stamp Set**
 - Wild Bunch
- **Dies**
 - Stylish Shapes Dies (circle)
- **Cardstock**
 - Basic White
 - Real Red
 - Smoky Slate
- **Ink**
 - Memento Tuxedo Black
 - VersaMark
- **Embossing**
 - White Emboss Powder
- **Adhesives**
 - Stampin' Dimensionals
 - Liquid Glue



REBECCA'S TIP

The first few letters of "Happy" didn't emboss well, so I traced them with a White Gel Pen instead of starting over. It blended right in and saved the project!



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
